



COVID-19 –Cleaning & Disinfecting Guidance

1. Goal

The Lynden School District is implementing this cleaning and disinfection protocol with the goal of ensuring healthy and safe campuses. To use best practices to reduce, mitigate and help eliminate the spread of the Covid-19 virus within our buildings. To keep student, staff and the visiting public safe.

2. General

The frequency of cleaning and disinfection has been increased in all LSD owned and leased facilities, focusing on high touch point surfaces throughout the buildings.

3. Understanding how Covid-19 spreads

The virus that causes Covid-19 is mainly spread by respiratory droplets. When an infected person coughs or sneezes, respiratory droplets that contain the virus are expelled into the air and can be breathed in by someone in the area. Although the virus can not enter your body through contact with skin, it can get into your airways or mucous membranes from your eyes, nose, or mouth. There is little evidence that the virus can be caught simply by touching a surface and that is why washing your hand often for 20 seconds or longer and wearing a facemask are essential.

4. Cleaning and Disinfecting

Routine cleaning & disinfecting is key to maintaining a safe environment for all student, staff, and visitors.

- Clean all surfaces and objects prior to disinfection.
- Use only chemicals approved by LSD (Appendix (A))
- Follow all manufactures use & disposal directions on the label.
- Use disposable gloves and eye protection during EC&D if desired.
- Conduct all work in properly ventilated space.
- Continually ensure worker safety and hydration.
- Special emphasis on high touch/use surfaces.
- Vacuum carpets or mop floors after cleaning/disinfecting.



The LSD has approved several products for Cleaning & Disinfection. (The list is included on Appendix (A)). Schools are free to choose chemicals that have worked well for them in the past and that they are familiar with. All products approved for *cleaning use only* are specifically identified. All approved products to be used for disinfection have active ingredients that are listed and approved by the EPA's List N: Disinfectants for Use Against SARS-Co-2 (Covid-19). No homemade products, or products not listed on the EPA's List N (Appendix (A)) are to be used in any LSD facility.
